Scholarship Amount: A minimum \$500 individual scholarship is awarded with a net total awarded to all graduates up to \$4,000.00

Selection Criteria: A committee of Optimist Club members will make selections based upon an applicant's commitment to community service, financial need, recommendations and dedication to academics (a minimum GPA of 2.50).

Application Process: Complete this application and return to the Optimist Club of Jackson by **May 1** of your senior year, along with:

- A copy of your academic transcript
- FAFSA or SAR
- Two letters of recommendation

Fund Distribution: The scholarships will be paid directly to the college/university of the student's choice upon receipt of that institution's billing invoice. These funds may be used for tuition, books, food and/or living expenses associated with higher education.
